

# Notice of Tax Revenue Increase

The Mitchell County Hospital District conducted public hearings on August 19, 2010 and August 23, 2010 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Mitchell County Hospital District from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 4.67 percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.267000 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$2,164,312.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.216000 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$2,264,640.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.216000 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$2,275,499.

The Mitchell County Hospital District of Mitchell County Hospital District is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on August 31, 2010 at 997 West I-20, Colorado City, Texas 79512 at 5:00 pm.
